Families,

In December, I submitted to the Honourable Zach Churchill, Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development, a report with a recommendation to consolidate Gaetz Brook Junior High (GBJH) and Eastern Shore District High (ESDH) when a new school is built on the Eastern Shore.

I am pleased to inform you that earlier today, I received confirmation that the Minister has accepted the recommendation. The new school will be designed and constructed as a Grade 7 to 12 school. The provincial government announced this consolidation along with the site selected for the new school in a news release today. I want to again thank everyone who offered their input during the consultation process.
