Families,

You've been sharing, and we've been listening!

Last week we let you know about some upcoming changes to address significant growth pressures in the Woodlawn High Family of Schools (FOS). To review those changes, <u>click here</u>.

Thanks to those who have taken the time to share their thoughts with us. Since last week, we have heard from over 230 participants who shared 170 thoughts and offered 4,500 ratings on *ThoughtExchange*. We are excited to see this level of community engagement!

### What have we heard so far?

# Q. Why are families only finding out this information now? Why weren't families consulted first?

**A.** Where possible and when there is a long timeframe, we undertake community consultations with a focus on options. However, to manage the rapid growth HRCE is facing from year to year, consultations with families have not always been possible.

February is registration month, so planning for the fall begins in March once we have updated enrolment projections. There is a short runway to address challenges created by significant growth, analyze options, and finalize plans for September as planning for the following school year (staffing, programming, transportation) starts mid-April.

#### Q. What are the projected enrolment numbers for Portland Estates Elementary?

**A.** The Long-Range Outlook currently published on our website is based on enrolment data from January 2022. The chart below outlines the updated projected enrolment as of January 2023. **Note: these calculations do not include the portables.**

#### Q. What about the portables at Portland Estates Elementary?

**A.** With Portland Estates Elementary transitioning from a PP-6 school to a PP-5 school effective September 2023, portables will be moved as they are required to support growth in other HRCE schools.

# Q. How many students from Portland Estates Elementary will be eligible for the bus to Ellenvale Junior High?

**A.** Our preliminary data shows that approximately 95% of students currently in Grade 5 at Portland Estates Elementary will be eligible for the bus in Grade 6 to Ellenvale Junior High. Families eligible for transportation will receive an email to access the Parent Portal and view their child's bus information once it is available.
