Families,

I am writing to let you know about some upcoming changes to address significant growth pressures in the Millwood High Family of Schools (FOS).

As the population continues to grow in Halifax Regional Municipality, student enrolment is rising in the Halifax Regional Centre for Education. The Millwood High FOS is becoming one of the fastest growing areas. To ensure all students have safe, welcoming, and comfortable learning spaces, some changes are necessary.

Modular Units

Last fall, we let families at Harry R. Hamilton Elementary know that <u>a modular unit</u> would be built this spring to ease these pressures. The 6-classroom addition is placed at Harry R. Hamilton Elementary and will help support growth in surrounding schools.

Effective September 2023, grade configurations will change at some schools in the Millwood High FOS.

Changes in the Millwood High Family of Schools

- **Harry R. Hamilton Elementary:** no change, will remain Grades PP-5. Will now receive Pre-Primary from Millwood Elementary and Sackville Heights Elementary.
- **Millwood Elementary:** will remain Grades PP-5, except Pre-Primary will now be offered offsite at Harry R. Hamilton Elementary.
- Millwood High: no change, will remain Grades 9-12.
- Sackville Heights Elementary: will remain Grades PP-5, except Pre-Primary will now be offered offsite at Harry R. Hamilton Elementary.
- Sackville Heights Junior High: no change, will remain Grades 6-8 English and Grades 7-8 French Immersion.
