

**Clayton Park School  
Construction Progress Update  
August 13, 2026**

RCS Construction Inc. is the general contractor for the construction of the new Clayton Park-Fairview 6-9 School. RCS will make every effort to minimize impacts on neighbours and will follow HRM construction guidelines including site access, traffic control, and noise restrictions.

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**Activities**

1. **Foundation preparation activities** continued on site, with concrete pours completed for multiple footings and foundation walls. First-floor foundation walls and columns are nearing completion. This work includes formwork, insulation, rebar installation, and concrete pours.
2. **Foundation work for the second floor** is ongoing, including formwork, rebar installation, and concrete pours.
3. **HRM Mainland Trail closure** and the connecting trails to Brackley Place and Thackeray Close were approved and commenced on July 20. The closure is planned to remain in place until August 28 to facilitate the installation of sanitary and storm services from the rear portion of the school. Active installation work is ongoing along the trails behind Thackeray Close and Brackley Place.
4. **Upcoming works** include continued installation of storm and sanitary services and ongoing foundation work for the first and second floors. Underground mechanical and electrical service installations are planned to resume in August. The steel fabricator is anticipated to mobilize to site next week, with steel deliveries also expected to begin next week.
5. **The final package for full school completion** has been approved and will introduce additional construction scope to the project over the coming months.
