Dear Parent/Guardian/Staff,

Public Health is investigating a confirmed case of COVID-19. The person who tested positive is connected with St. Margaret's Bay School.

We recognize that receiving this information may be stressful and want to ensure you understand the process going forward.

Public Health has been in touch with all close contacts for your school.

**No further action is needed of you or your child at this time.**

- fever
