The Halifax Regional Centre for Education has been advised by the provincial government that the anticipated completion date of the new Eastern District P-12 school construction project has been moved to January 2020.

While the new building will not be ready to open at the start of the school year, we are continuing to move forward with transitioning all students into one school community at the Duncan MacMillan site for the start of the school year in September 2019.

This will give all students the opportunity to start building connections with teachers and classmates from the beginning of the school year. It will also ensure students and their families can establish one set of routines, for things like transportation, without having to change mid-year.

I know everyone will continue to work together throughout the transition to ensure both a successful start to the school year and a successful transition into the new building. You can expect to receive regular communication updates as the project progresses.
