Eastern Shore Consultation – Frequently Asked Questions

Why is this happening?

A new high school for the Eastern Shore area was announced in 2018 as part of the provincial multi-year capital plan.

In 2019, the School Advisory Council (SAC) for Gaetz Brook Junior High asked if this new school could include students from their school, making the capital project a new grade 7-12 school.

The Halifax Regional Centre for Education (HRCE) would like to gather feedback from families, staff and community on the consolidation of these two schools.

Why now?

It is important to do the consultation before the design of the new school is completed and construction begins.

Which schools are involved?

The consultation is open to the general public. We are sharing it directly with Eastern Shore District High, Gaetz Brook Junior High, O'Connell Drive Elementary and Porter's Lake Elementary.

The only schools being considered for consolidation are Gaetz Brook Junior High and Eastern Shore District High.

What is the anticipated timeline?

The process will begin immediately and the community will have until the end of November to share feedback.

Will there be a public meeting?

We know conducting a consultation during a pandemic needs to be very different. We are offering multiple options for people to select the way that works best for them to share their thoughts and ideas. This will also allow you to provide feedback at the time most convenient.
