As Nova Scotia is supporting safe planning during the global pandemic, all international students arriving in Nova Scotia expecting to attend a school within the Halifax Regional Centre for Education must notify HRCE's International Services at 902-464-2000 Ext. 2547. DO NOT proceed to a school prior to contacting International Services.

Fee paying students must follow all provincial and federal guidelines. These guidelines include, but are not limited to, having received the entire series of an accepted COVID-19 vaccine or a complete series of a combination of accepted vaccines, receiving their last dose at least 14 full days before entering Canada. To be considered fully vaccinated, you must follow the guidelines set by the Government of Canada: <https://travel.gc.ca/travel-covid/travel-restrictions/covid-vaccinated-travellers-entering-canada>.

Everyone who travels from outside Atlantic Canada into Nova Scotia must follow Nova Scotia Public Health guidelines. Tuition fees must be paid in full before a Letter of Acceptance is issued. Tuition fees are based on the cost of providing an education to an individual student and do not cover accommodations, board or Medical Insurance. Medical Insurance must be obtained prior to arrival in Canada through the Halifax Regional Centre of Education.

REFUND REGULATIONS

The \$200.00 (Canadian Funds) forwarded with your application is non-refundable. All requests for a refund must be made in writing. The following regulations will apply:

If the international student does not, for any reason, receive a student Visa, the fees will be refunded in full, less the application fee of \$200.00. The applicant must include documentation from Immigration Canada in order to receive the full refund. For all other refunds, 30 days’ notice must be given to obtain a refund for any subsequent months tuition paid less the application fee of \$200.00. All refunds will be issued by cheque. If cheques have to be mailed internationally, a \$100 courier fee will be deducted from the refund.
