Dear Parents/Guardians,

With the last few days of March upon us, I feel it is timely to provide you with an update on plans to relocate students across the street to the former Beaufort building in September. Between now and the end of the school year, there will be several things that will happen, including:

- a tender document for renovations to the building issued in early April;
- Université Sainte-Anne vacating the premises by the end of April; and
- renovations to the building to accommodate elementary programming beginning in May.

Renovations will be completed over the summer prior to the students and staff returning to the school. I want to thank the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development for agreeing to fund these renovations.

I am also pleased that the Minister is funding the installation of a portable classroom. The portable will be used to support the music and band programs which will allow physical education to be offered onsite rather than having to transport students to another facility.

I want to thank both the school's administration and the School Advisory Council for working together on transition plans.
