Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to provide you with an update to my letter in October regarding the relocation of students during the construction of the new school.

I can confirm that all LeMarchant-St. Thomas students will be relocated across the street to the former Beaufort building and the Beaufort Annex. I know there has been some concern the Halifax Regional School Board (HRSB) may need to relocate students to other schools, but a thorough evaluation of the space has confirmed our original assessment regarding the placement of students.

HRSB staff will be working with the school's administration and the School Advisory Council to plan for a smooth transition. I suspect this process will begin early in the new year. Among the details to be finalized are the delivery of programs including music, band, physical education, art and EXCEL. We will work with the school to ensure you receive regular updates on transition plans as they are developed.

If you have any questions, I would encourage you to contact the school and speak with one of the administrators. They should be able to answer any of your questions or direct you to the appropriate contact at the board for a response.
