Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to provide you with an update on the relocation of students during the construction of the new school.

It is the intention of the Halifax Regional School Board (HRSB) to use the former Beaufort building located on the corner of Walnut and Watt streets in our relocation plans. This building is currently occupied by the Université Sainte-Anne but remains the property of the HRSB.

There will be some renovations to undertake next spring when the university vacates the building but the board remains optimistic all students will be able to be accommodated between this space and the existing space in the Beaufort Annex.

We still have many details to work out between now and next September but I want to assure you we will work closely with the school's administration and the community to plan for a smooth transition.
