

Public Health Notice to School Community

Confirmed Case in School

Dear Parent/Guardian/Staff,

Public Health is investigating a confirmed case of COVID-19. The person who tested positive is connected with **Tallahassee Community School**. Based on our findings to date, potential exposure to COVID-19 could have happened on **December 7, or December 8**.

We recognize that receiving this information may be stressful and want to ensure you understand the process going forward.

Through our investigation, Public Health will:

- identify anyone who has come into close contact with the case
- send a letter to all close contacts as soon as possible
- arrange testing for close contacts

If you do not receive the letter and phone call, your child is NOT a close contact. No further action is needed of you or your child at this time.

All parents/guardians are reminded to monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 daily. The daily checklist is available at <https://novascotia.ca/coronavirus/docs/Daily-COVID-checklist-en.pdf>

If you, your child or anyone in your household has or develops:

- fever
- cough (new or worsening)
- sore throat
- runny nose
- headache
- shortness of breath
